Admiral Jamie Foggo is a 1981 graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy. He retired after 39 years of active duty in late 2020 after almost a decade of service in Europe, Africa and the Middle East and three years as a Four-Star Admiral and Commander of the Trifecta—Naval Forces Europe, Naval Forces Africa and Allied Joint Force Command, Naples, Italy.

Over the last decade in Naples, Italy, he served in multiple major commands as Commander, Naval Forces Europe/Africa; Commander Allied Joint Force Command, Naples; Commander, U.S. Sixth Fleet; Commander, Submarine Group 8; and Commander, Submarines, Allied Naval Forces South. During this period, he also served as the Operations Officer (J-3) for Joint Task Force Odyssey Dawn (Libya). Additionally, Foggo was a NATO Task Force commander in Joint Task Force Unified Protector (Libya). In 2018, he commanded Exercise Trident Juncture (Arctic Circle), the largest NATO exercise since the Cold War with over 50,000 personnel.

Ashore, he has served in a variety of assignments, most notably as Executive Assistant to the Director of Naval Nuclear Propulsion (NAVSEA 08); Executive Assistant to Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff; Executive Officer to the Supreme Allied Commander Europe (SACEUR) & Commander, European Command (EUCOM); & Director, Navy Staff.

Foggo is also a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and the Explorer's Club of New York and has served on Advisory Boards to the Naval Submarine League, Olmsted Foundation Board, U. S. Naval Institute Board and is currently an active member of the Marine Corps University Editorial Board in Quantico, VA.
